Please find a range of activities for children to do to support and continue their learning. We strongly recommend you continue practising your child's phonics sounds which can be found in the central section of your reading diary and please continue to read daily.

R.E	Write your own special prayer and teach it to your family.	Create a poster for The Year of The Word.	Find out what you can about Holy Week and draw a picture and write a caption for each day.
Writing	Write a character description, based on a character from their favourite book.	Keep a journal of the things you do each day.	Write a review of each book that you read. Perhaps you could continue the story.
Reading	Follow instructions to bake or create something.	Read a book and write your own questions for a family member to find the answer.	Choose your favourite soft toys and read them a story in your best storytelling voice.
Maths	Make a clock and tell the time to every half past and o'clock.	How many ways to make 20 Play lots of card games and board games, maybe make your own.	Play shops using coins to make different small amounts.
Other	Research and create a fact file about Neil Armstrong.	Create a collage on the five animal groups (mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, amphibians) Cut out pictures or draw your own.	Find Kids Yoga on You Tube and stretch your bodies!
