Theatre Visit

This summer we have booked visiting theatre groups so that all our children have the chance to experience and take part in, an age appropriate production. KS2 classes will see 'The Railway Children', KS1 classes will see 'The Story of Aesop's Fables' and our Early Years classes will see a performance of 'The Gingerbread Man'. We would be grateful to receive a donation of £2.50 per child towards the costs. Please send these into school as soon as possible using the reply slip at the end of the newsletter.

KS2 Production

The KS2 Summer Production will be held on **Monday 27th June and Tuesday 28th June**. There will be an afternoon (2.00pm) and evening (7.00pm) performance on each of these dates. Year 4, 5 and 6 will be performing in all four performances with Year 3 Lisbon performing in both Monday performances and Year 3 Padua in both Tuesday performances. Numbers for the evening performances will need to be restricted, so we will be sending home two tickets for each family.

We would be grateful if you could return any unwanted tickets to the school office so they can be reallocated. We do not expect the demand for seats at the afternoon performance to be as great, therefore numbers will not be restricted for this performance.

All children in the school will have seen the play. We therefore ask that you **do not** bring them again to the evening performance. Children below school age should be brought to the afternoon performance and **not** the evening performance and for safety reasons buggies must be left outside the hall.

Please make sure you organise baby sitters in advance as *all* children who attend our school as well as pre-school children, will be refused admission. It is very upsetting for parents to miss their child's performance because they have not made the appropriate arrangements and also for the staff who have to take this action.
