

## Maths:

We played a board game this week using a dice. The children had to roll the dice and put that many characters on their bus. The characters were in a feely bag so they couldn't see and if they picked up any cats we talked about their amount going down as cats had to get off. At the end we saw who had the most and who had the least passengers on their bus.

Next week we will be sorting objects according into big, medium and small, and hot or cold and soft or hard.

## Phonics and Home Learning:

This week we learned the 'm' sound. I have set home learning on teams around subitising (recognising how many without having to count) and the m sound.

## RE:

This week we read the Creation story and learnt how God made the world in one week. He made the land, sea and sky and filled in with animals and plants. We created our own worlds using paper plates, paint and tissue paper. We thought about something we each love about our world.

## Literacy:

This week we have been reading fiction and non-fiction texts about London. We read 'Bernie Bus Goes to London' and 'The Queen's Hat'. We made our own cereal box bus, gem encrusted crown and split pin soldier. A big London bus had appeared in our role play area so we had to take turns waiting at the bus stop.

Next week we will begin our Fairy Tale theme by reading Goldie Locks and the Three Bears. We will think about our favourite parts of the story, favourite characters and whether we would like to visit their house or not and why.
