RE

This week we have been discussing how people act in a certain way because of their faith. We have been thinking about ways we take care of each other as a Pentecost Person in our class, home, school and community.

Next week we shall be consolidating all we have learnt this half term about Pentecost and Eastertide.

English

We have been working on 'An Alien Tea on Planet Zum Zee' by Tony Mitton and Guy Parker-Rees. We have sorted adjectives and phonics sounds used in the book. The children have created their own ideas for an alien tea and written descriptions of different foods in their books.

Next week we shall continue working on this book.

Maths

This week in maths we have been learning about odd and even numbers and how to identify them. The children have had lots of practical maths time learning how to share into equal and unequal parts.

Next week we shall be continuing with the first steps of division looking at equal and unequal groups and remainders.

Science

This week we wrote step-by-step instructions about how we planted our seeds. The children are monitoring the growth every day. The seeds are being very slow to germinate, we are putting this down to the unusual May weather we are currently experiencing; we are hoping to 'pot on' the seeds next week to see how they grow.
