


Year 2

Maths	How many ways can you make 100? Using $x + - \div$	Using the inverse to find missing numbers: e.g $\underline{\quad} - 13 = 45$ $45 + 13 = 58$	Find different fractions of an amount 	Pick any two digit numbers and use these to add and subtract using the column method.
Writing	Write a setting description, thinking about the different senses.	Grab your favourite book and sort the words into: Adjectives, nouns, adverbs and verbs.	Make sentences using these conjunctions: but, or, because, when and that.	Find as many contractions as you can in your books. Do you know the two words that make them? Can't = can not
Reading	Follow instructions to bake or create something.	Read a book and write your own questions for a family member to find the answer.	Read in the most unusual place and take a photo to share to the class.	Read and learn a poem off by heart.
Other	Read and retell the story of Palm Sunday making sure that it is in a chronological order.	Create a picture inspired by Van Gogh.	Research and create a project on John Dunlop.	Create an Easter bonnet.
