

# Year 3 Lisbon Update 10.12.21


In RE this week, the children have learnt about the stories of the Annunciation and the Visitation. As we prepare for the coming of Jesus, we remember and hear about the special visits both Mary and Elizabeth experienced. Next week in RE, the children will be exploring Luke's account of the Nativity and the visit of the shepherds.

In English, the children have completed their learning on the story of Mini Rabbit not lost. They have applied their knowledge of inverted commas to add dialogue between characters in their writing and have written a description of the final part of the story.

In Maths, the children have practised solving word problems using the inverse and have moved onto using column method for addition. Some important vocabulary we have explored this week is as follows: inverse, exchange and regroup.







In this column addition question, the 10 ones are exchanged and regrouped into 1 ten, which is recorded at the bottom of the tens column.

In Science, following on from last week's Science work, the children have investigated if all metals are magnetic.

# **Spelling**

This week the children have practised adding le to words. Please see the rules below.

- Where the word contains a short vowel before a consonant, that consonant is doubled before adding le.
- When the consonant is followed by two different consonants, there is no need to double the final one, as in jungle or jingle
