English

In English this week, we have continued our learning about Greek Myths. We completed some research on Greek gods and completed a fact file about one of them. We also read a new Greek myth - Pandora's Box - and we did some role play around this story. In our grammar lessons we have been practising editing punctuation and spelling errors.
