This week in RE, we have been learning about Confirmation. We learnt about the different symbols that we might see during confirmation and discussed what these represent. We also linked this back to baptism and highlighted the similarities between the promises made in both sacraments. Next week we will be continuing our learning about confirmation and will be learning about the service and the reasons why we make this sacrament.

English

Maths

$$145 \div 5 = 29$$

$$362 \div 7 = 51 \text{ r}5$$

Next week in maths we will be moving on using these methods to answer word problems.

In science this week we have been learning about Thomas Edison and some of his amazing inventions. We have also planned another experiment which we will be doing next week.
