

R.E

This week in R.E we have been continuing with our learning about communities. We have been thinking about the different people that are involved in these communities and what their roles are. We have also been learning about our local parish church Holy Rood. We have been learning about the different people involved in the parish community and why everyone is important. Next week in R.E we will be learning about how the different people in the parish serve the community.

English

In English this week we have completed our research for our non-chronological report. The children chose the animal that they wanted to write their report on and they have now written their introduction and their first paragraph. After this, they were able to edit their paragraph and then improve it. Next week we will continue with our draft of our report.

Maths

This week in maths we have been using the bus stop method for division. We have been able to divide 3 and 4 digit numbers by 1 digit and the children have been able to work with remainders. There is an example below.

$$\begin{array}{r} 362 \div 7 = \\ \begin{array}{r} 5 \ 1 \ r5 \\ 7 \overline{) 3 \ 6 \ 2} \\ \underline{3 \ 5} \phantom{2} \\ 1 \ 2 \end{array} \\ 362 \div 7 = 51 \ r5 \end{array}$$

Next week in maths we will be moving on to shape.

The children will be identifying 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

In Science this week the children have been continuing with our learning on the digestive system. They completed a practical lesson where they were able to create their own digestive system. They really enjoyed this lesson and I am sure they would be able to talk to you about what they did. Next week in Science we will be starting to learn about our teeth.
