I would like to thank Ann, our Year 1 Padua teacher and RE co-ordinator, for organising a Fair trade raffle. I would also like to thank the staff who have donated all the Fair trade goodies. Stephanie, our Reception Lisbon TA has created lovely hampers using all the goodies. Thank you to all the children who have bought raffle tickets. The raffle has raised £590 for Fair trade which is fantastic. The winning tickets will be drawn from the raffle drum during our whole school assemblies on Tuesday 15th March.

School Lunches

Please remember that meal choices using the School Grid must be made in advance. There are children coming into school not having made a meal choice for the day which creates a lot of issues for the office and kitchen staff. Herts Catering have had to increase the cost of the price for a school meal with effect from 1st April 2022. From this date the meal price for Year 3 upwards will now be £2.80 per day.

Staff Training Day - school closure

On **Wednesday 6th July** there will be a training day for staff to implement a new systematic synthetic phonics teaching programme. This training is vital for staff and the training requires a whole day. Therefore, school will be closed for all children. The school will reopen for children on Thursday 7th July.

Year 3 and Year 4 Production - Jonah and the Whale.

We are very excited that for the first time our Year 3 and 4 classes will be involved in their own drama production. The staff are working very hard with the children and are looking forward to performing to an audience. We have decided to spread out the performance dates as we are still experiencing Covid cases among staff and children, therefore, each class will have a separate performance day.
