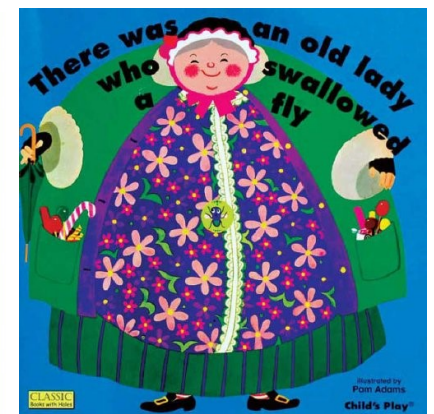
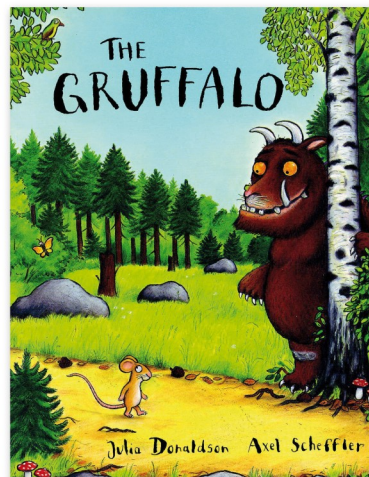
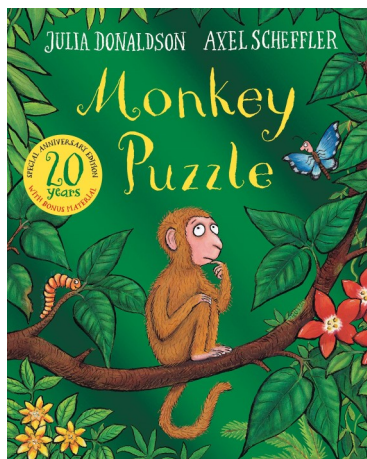
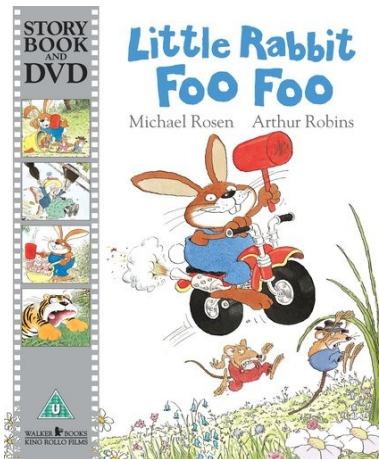
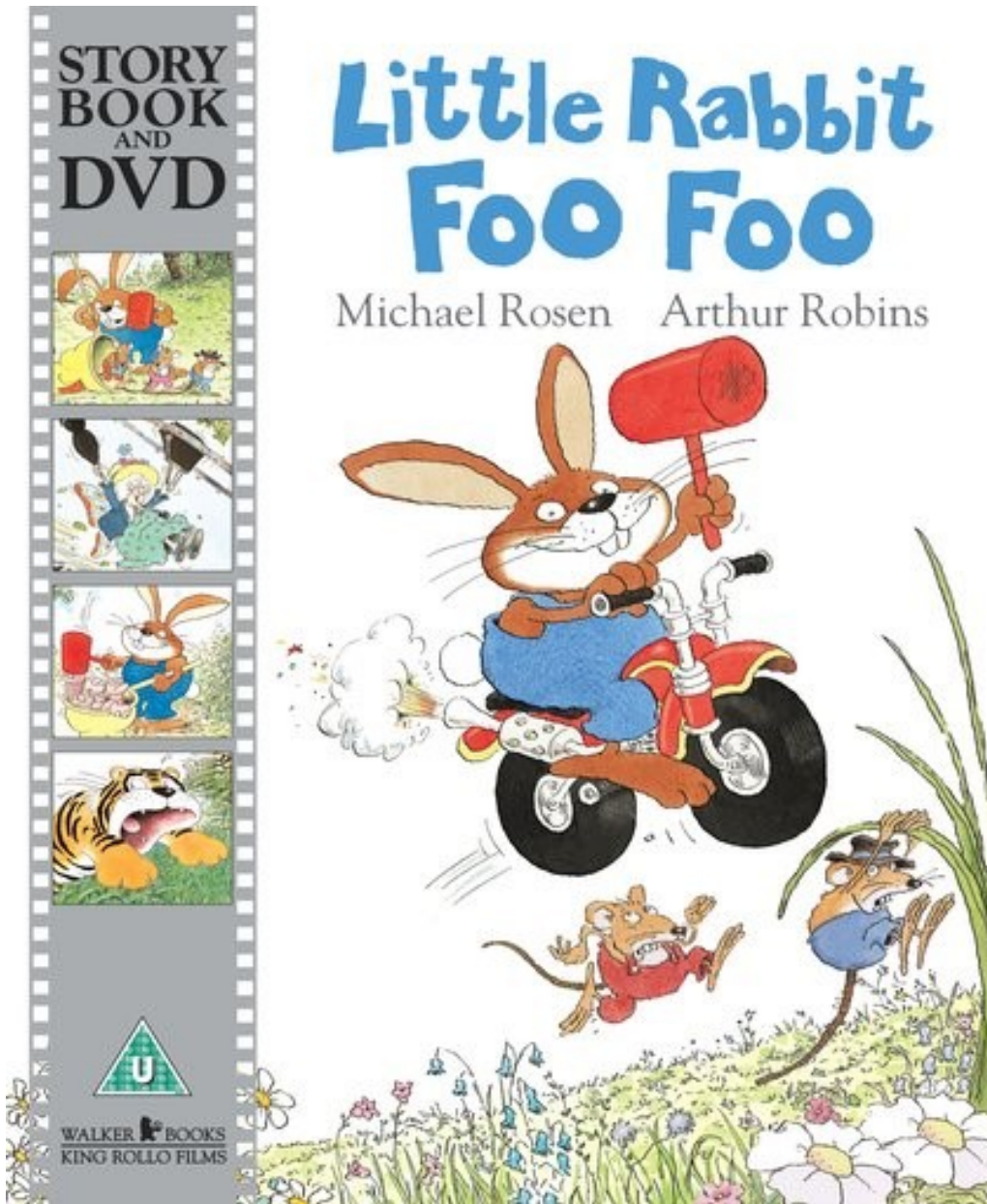


Autumn 1—Nursery's Must Read Books

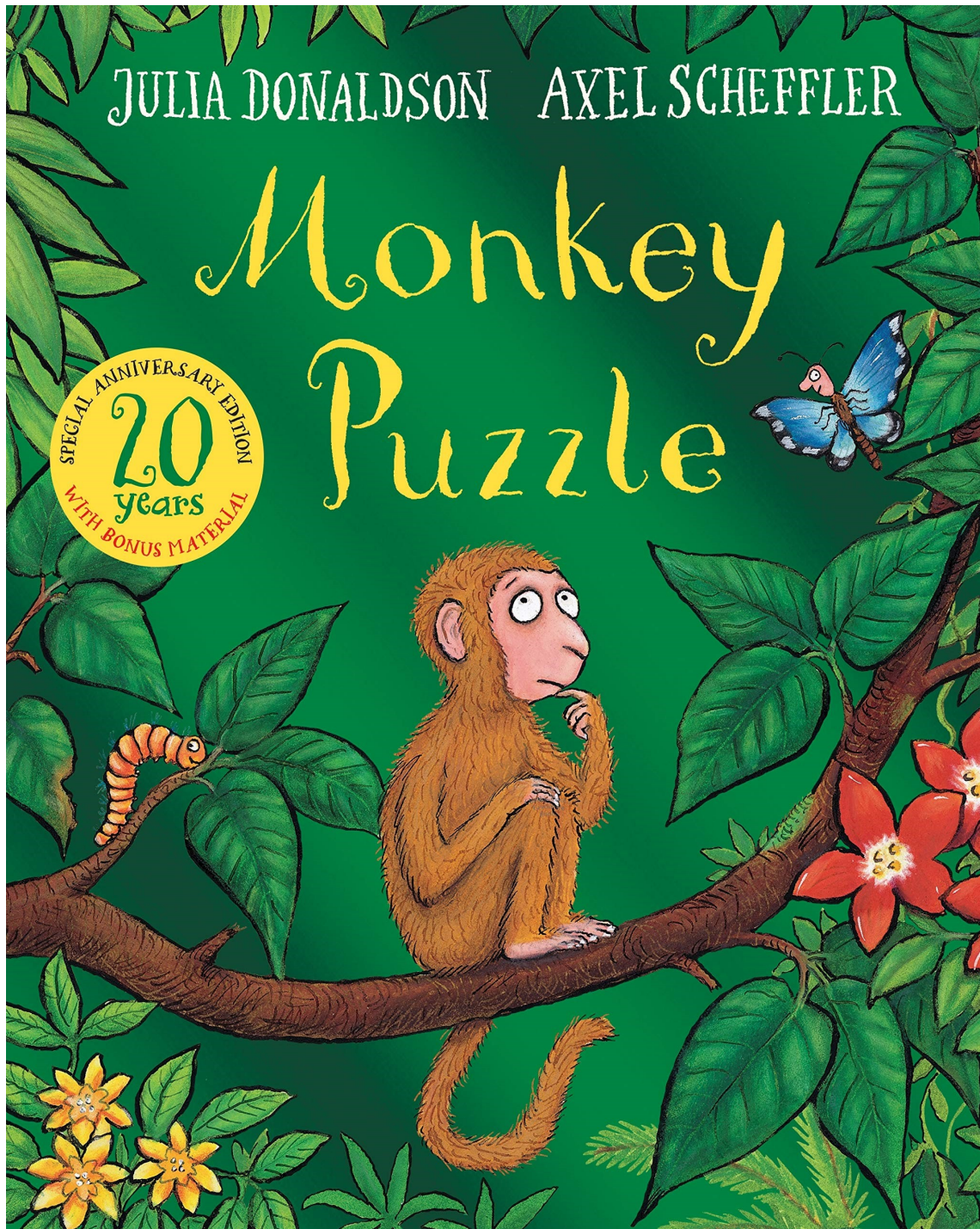
All books are available online or from bookstores of you would like to read them at home too.





This is a very simple, repetitive book.

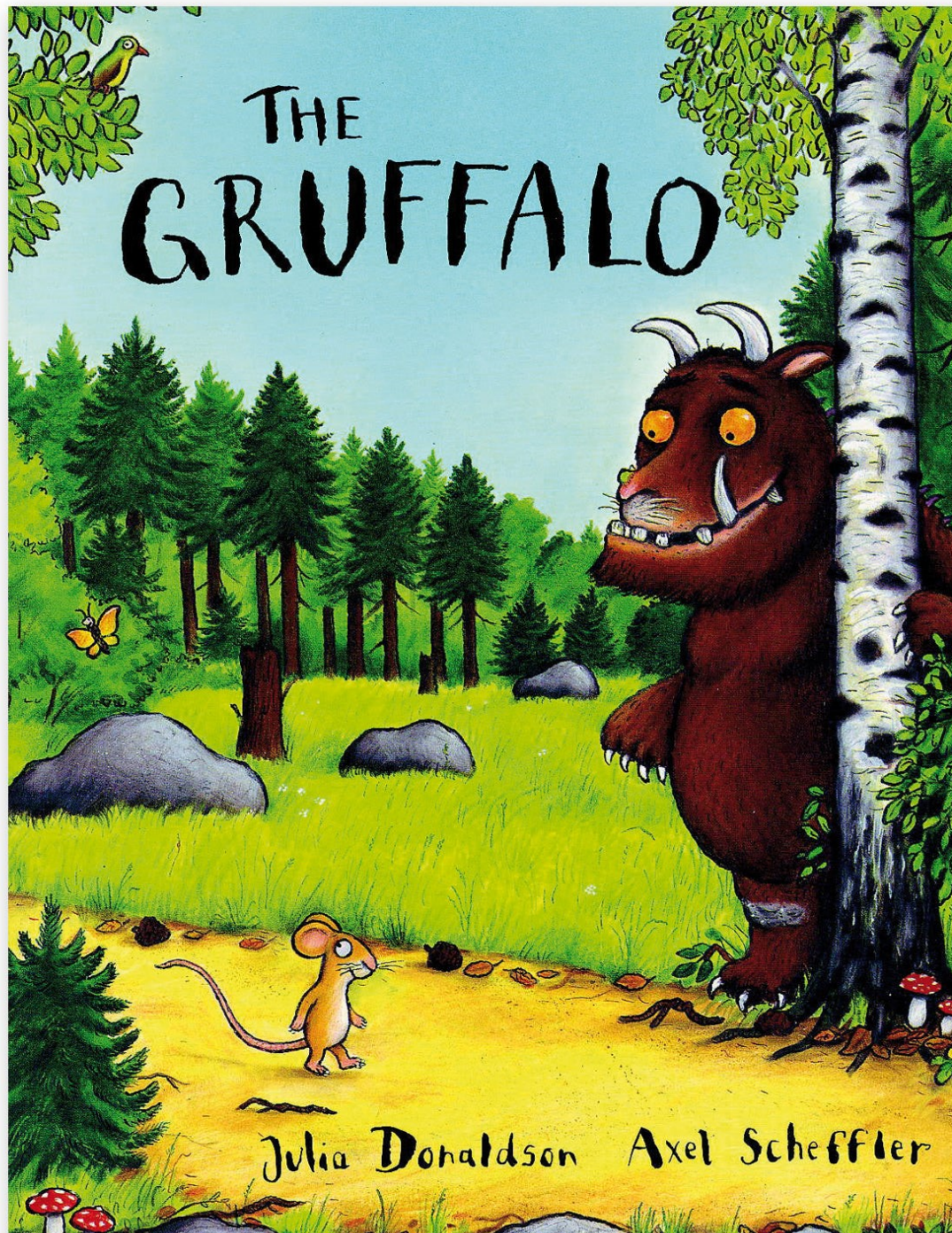
After while children will get to know the story well and be able to retell it all by themselves.



Monkey puzzle has the repeated refrain "no, no, no, that's a....".

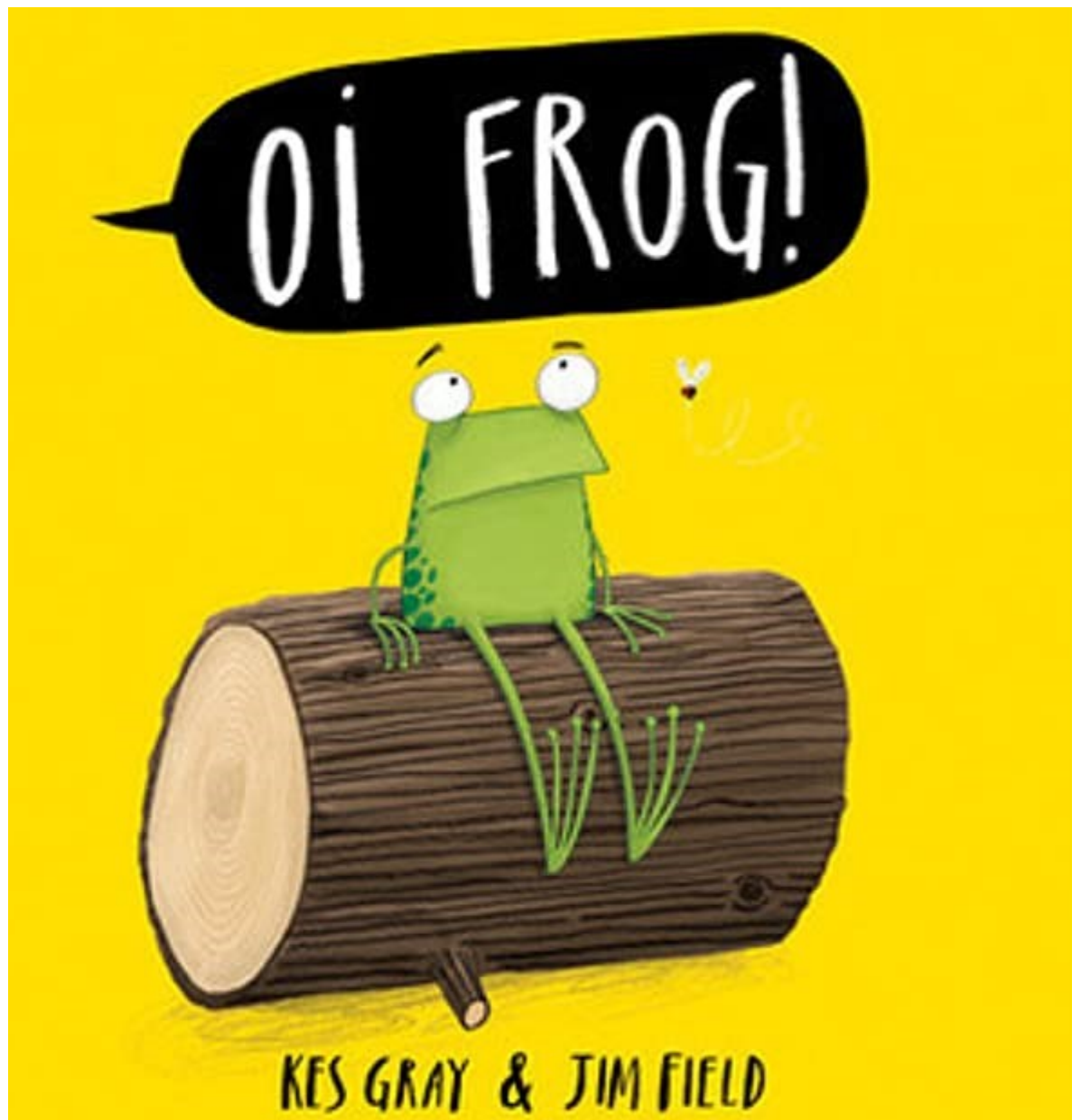
The children can join in with tell this part of the story.
