

Spring Term 1—Must Read Books
















Stickman

Oi Cat!


This is the third book in the 'Oi Frog' series. Not only does this book help children to understand rhyme but its also very funny and the children love to find out what the frog is going to sit on next!

The Lion Inside is a story about confidence, self-esteem and over coming shyness.


It is a lovely story to help those quieter children in the class begin to find their voice!

Sid is a cheeky cat who decides that living in one house and eating one dinner isn't enough!


This is a classic book from the 1990s that still makes children laugh today. It also helps us with our numbers as we count how many meals, owners or vet visits Sid has had.
