Attendance Update

The whole school attendance has been **94%** from 1st September until 21^{st h} February. We are hoping to see this improve to meet the **96%** minimum target set by the Government. Children who considered persistent absentees (under 90%) will be getting an email over the next week advising them that they are under 90% and therefore must ring daily when their child is off – they cannot email. The County Attendance Team are also coming into school soon to discuss school attendance and individual pupil attendance.
