## November – All Saints and All Souls

Thank you for all the effort you put in to the children's outfits for All Saints Day. It was lovely for them to be able to share their chosen saints with the rest of their class.

On All Saints Day Fr Alex celebrated mass with Year 2 and 5. This was a lovely occasion. We have planned for many more masses to take place throughout the year for all classes to attend.

#### Remembrance Day

The Royal British Legion have sent us some poppies and poppy related stationery to sell. This will be on sale before school on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> November** on the front and back playgrounds.

On Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November, all children will take part in special class liturgies to mark Remembrance Day. All children will also take part in a two minute silence at 11am.

#### Watford Food Bank – Thursday 10th November

We had an incredible response to our Foodbank donations in October. Many thanks. I would like to thank Mr and Mrs Kelly, two grandparents, who very kindly volunteered to help me to take all the food over to the Foodbank. The donations were weighed and the amount was 150kg – which the Watford Foodbank were delighted with. Our next donation day is **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> November**. Please contribute if you are able to. The boxes will be placed outside the main entrance, Nursery door and St Francis building door. Below is a list of the food needed:

- Bags of sugar (especially 500g bags)
- Tinned rice pudding/custard

Our children love watching them perform and they left the assembly singing their songs with all the actions. We were delighted to present Electric Umbrella with a donation of £120 from our school community.
