











# Reception Autumn Term Must Read Books




# Reception Autumn Term Must Read Books

Funny bones helps us to learn about our bodies. We learn about our different body parts, our skeletons, how to keep our bodies healthy and how to keep our teeth nice and clean.




We read the Little Red Hen during Harvest festival time. We learn where our food comes from. We also learn about different farm animals and how to share and help our friends.


## Wide-awake Hedgehog



'Wide awake Hedgehog' and 'After the Storm' help us to learn about autumn. In particular we learn about the changing colours and what hibernation means.




# Reception Autumn Term Must Read Books
