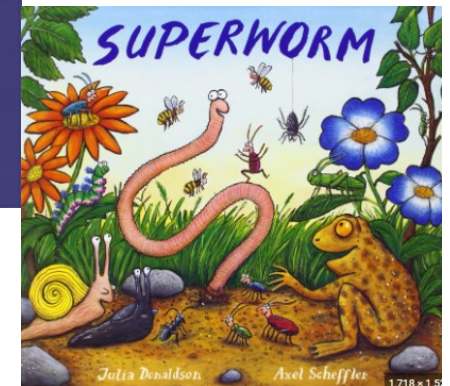
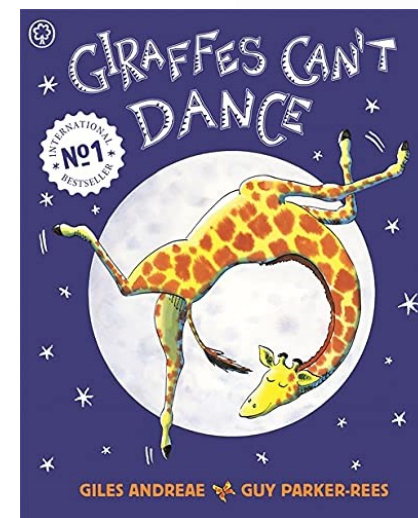
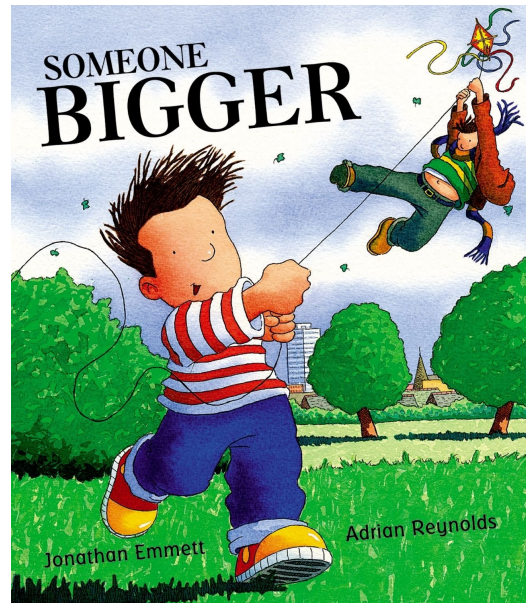
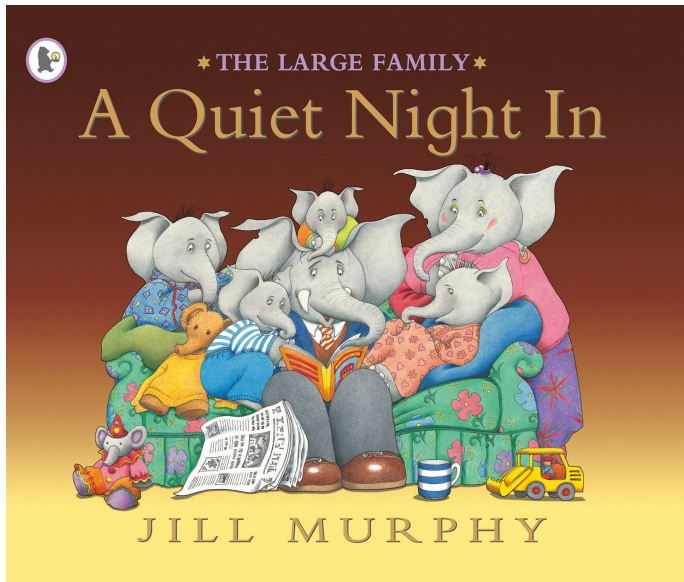
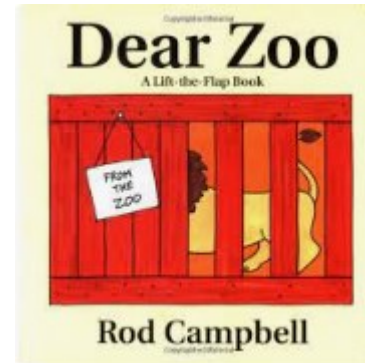


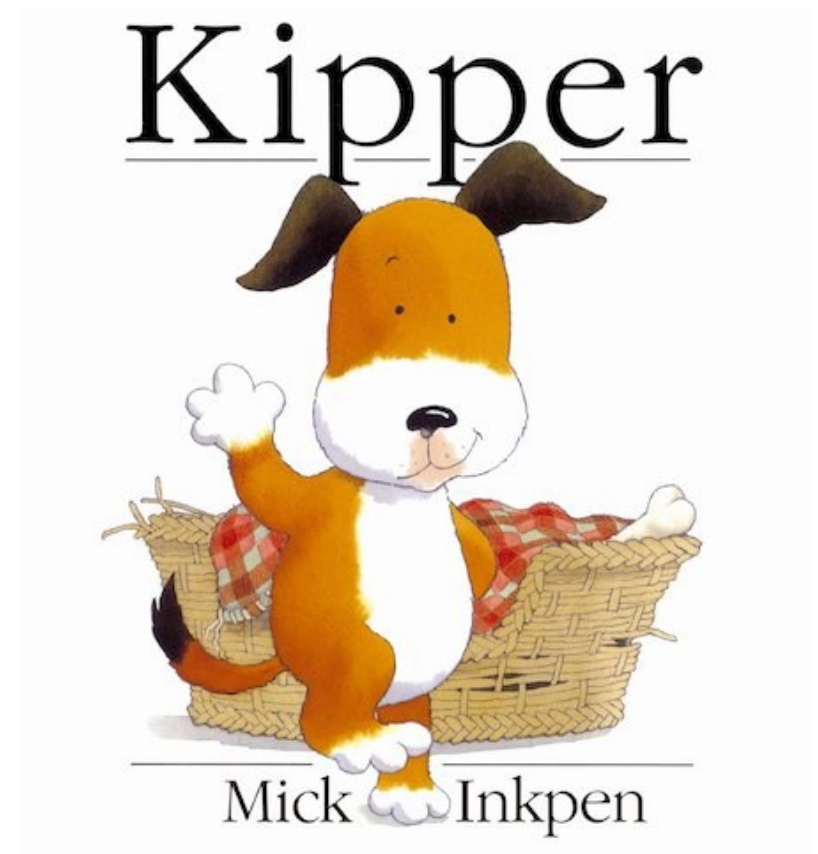
Summer Term 1—Must Read Books

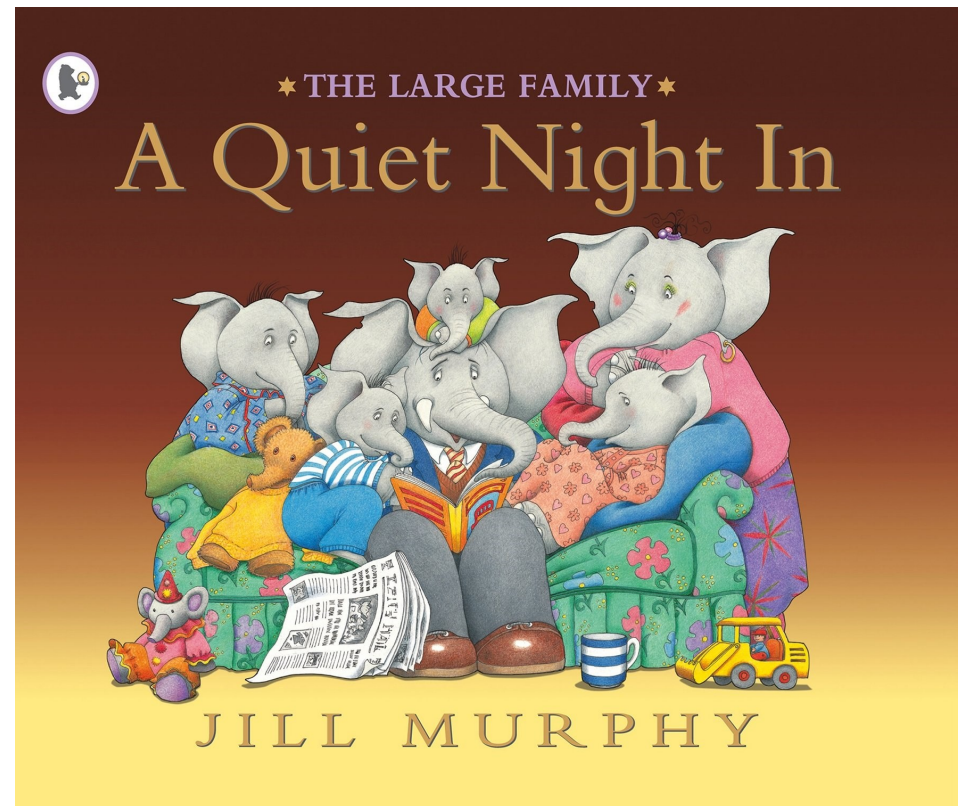
Kipper

Kipper is a classic children's character and the first book in a large series of Kipper books and Kipper and friends books.



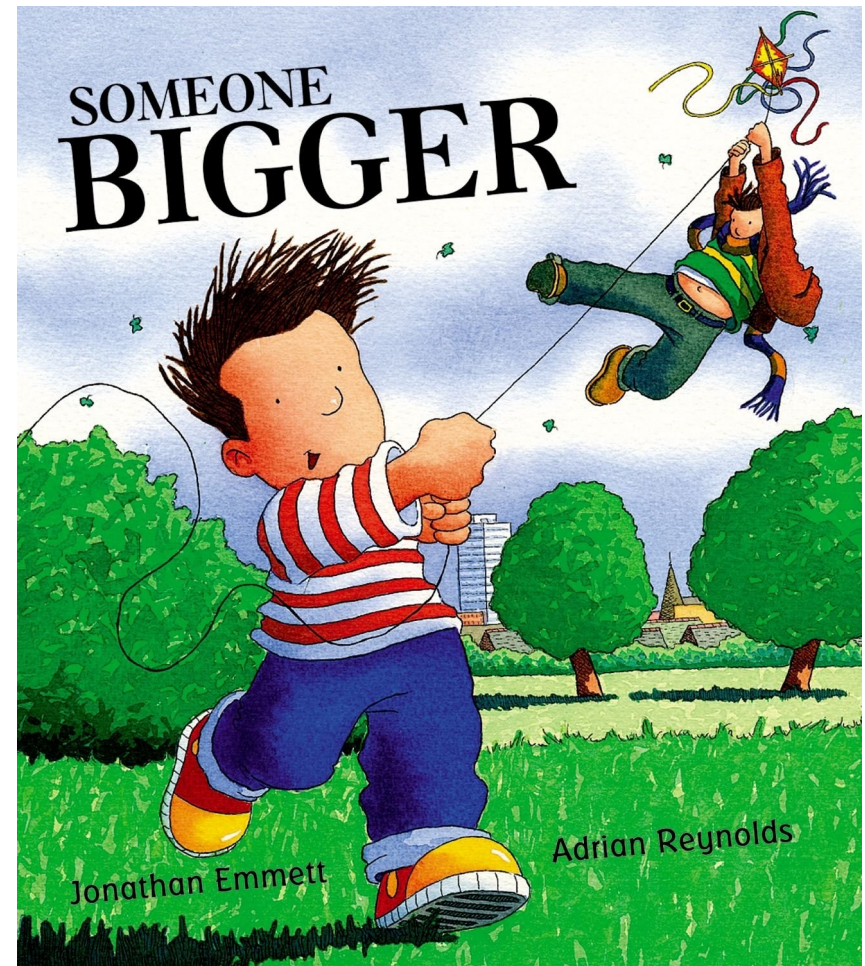
A Quiet Night In

Someone Bigger

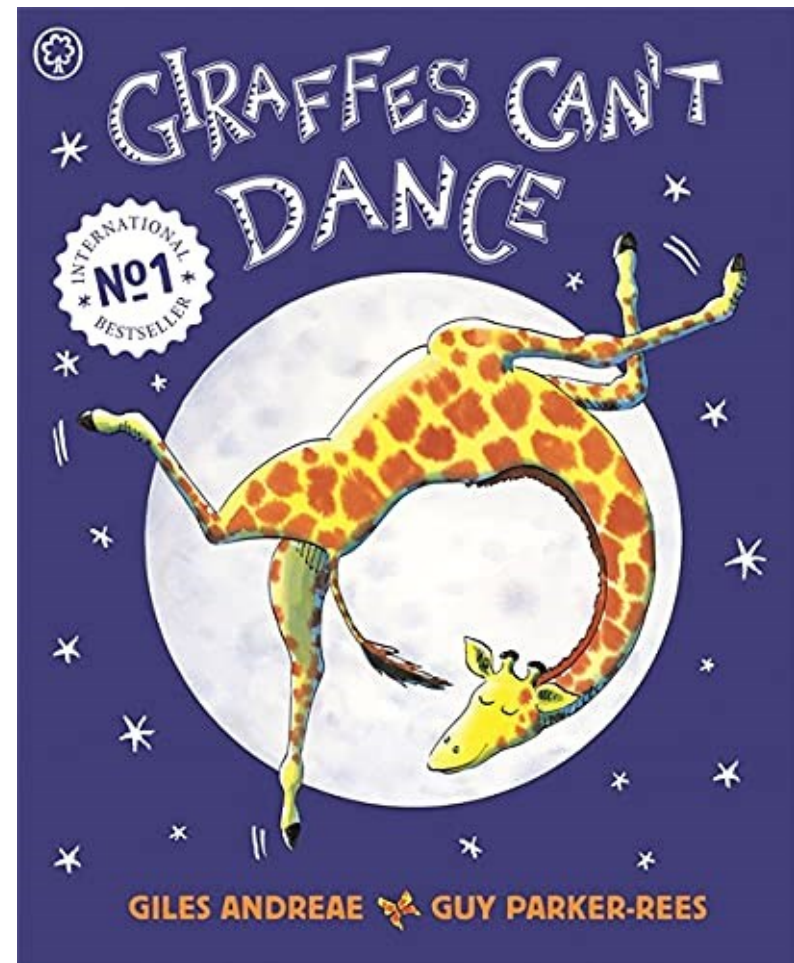
Someone bigger is a fun children's book that helps us to think about the size of objects and people. Join Sam and his Dad as they try to keep their kite from flying away.

Giraffe's can't dance is a lovely story that teaches children to give something a go even if they think they won't be good at it.

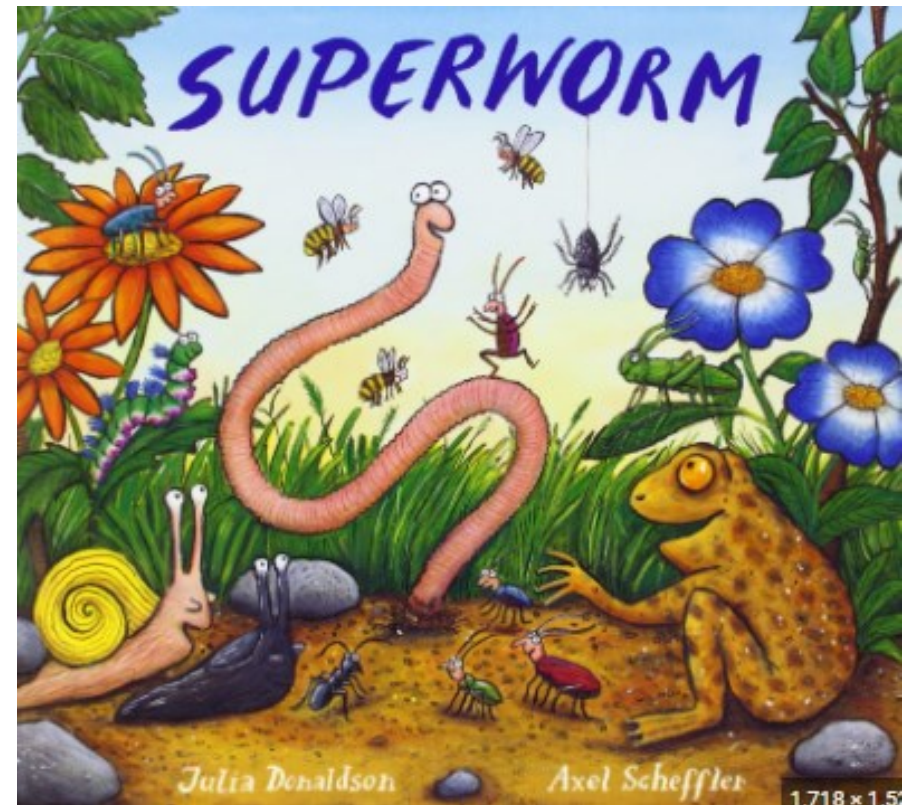
The story is told through rhyming verses which can help children to begin to re-tell the story themselves.
