





As well as being a well loved fairy tale, 'The Three Little Pigs' teachers us about different materials.



The children love this story with its scary giant—but it also teaches us about how things grow. We learn about plants and plant our own Beanstalks.




The gingerbread man gives the children an opportunity to learn how to cook! We make our own gingerbread men, and hope they don't runaway.
