<u>R.E</u>: This week we have been learning about the story of Moses and thinking about the reasons God chose him to lead the Israelites out of Egypt. We considered what makes a good leader and the children could recognise that Moses made a good leader because he listened to God.

Next week we will be starting our new topic 'Waiting'.

<u>Key vocabulary:</u> Waiting, preparing, Messenger, visit, celebrate, Advent, Jesus, Mary, Elizabeth, Joseph, shepherds, angels, Christmas, Bethlehem, manger, worship, wreath

Key vocabulary: Full stop, capital letter, finger spaces, instructions, first, then, next, finally

<u>Maths</u>: This week we have been working on subtraction within 10. We have carried out practical activities and moved on to pictorial representations.

Next week we will be learning about fact families.

<u>Key vocabulary:</u> Numbers 1- 10, ones, tens, digit, addition, add, more, and, make, sum, total, altogether, subtract, equals, take away, bonds, part-whole, part, whole.

<u>Science</u>: This week we made our own clay ammonites, the children worked really carefully rolling out the clay, spiraling them round and adding detail.

Next week we will be investigating the life of Mary Anning.


