<u>R.E</u>: This week we have introduced our new topic, 'Waiting'. We have been talking all about Advent. Please talk to your children about what they have found out about this important period in the Church Year.

Next week we will be holding our class retreats. We talk about the Christmas story and prepare and create our class Advent Calendar.


<u>Key vocabulary:</u> Waiting, preparing, Messenger, visit, celebrate, Advent, Jesus, Mary, Elizabeth, Joseph, shepherds, angels, Christmas, Bethlehem, manger, worship, wreath

<u>English</u>: This week we have continued our new book, 'The Lion Inside' by Rachel Bright and Jim Field. We have discussed the characteristics of the lion, thinking about how he looks on the outside and how he feels on the inside.

We will continue working on this book next week.

Key vocabulary: Full stop, capital letter, finger spaces, instructions, first, then, next, finally

<u>Maths</u>: This week we have been working on fact families. A fact family is a group of maths facts or equations that use the same numbers. A fact family in maths can show the relationship between addition and subtraction.



<u>Key vocabulary:</u> Numbers 1- 10, ones, tens, digit, addition, add, more, and, make, sum, total, altogether, subtract, equals, take away, bonds, part-whole, part, whole.

<u>Science</u>: This week we investigated what is a fossil and what is not a fossil. The children sorted pictures, labels and sentences of different artefacts successfully. We have been talking about the life of Mary Anning, next week the children will create a fact sheet about her.

Key vocabulary: Fossil, ammonite, paleontologist, dinosaurs, prehistoric, markings, stone


