#### Christmas Show 2023

Tickets for the Christmas show have been put in children's reading records today. For the Year 1 and Year 2 performance there will be an afternoon performance (2.30pm) and an evening performance (6pm) on **Thursday 7**<sup>th</sup> **December.** 

Numbers for the evening performance will need to be restricted so we will be sending home two tickets for each family. Please organise babysitters in advance as all children who attend our school as well as pre-school children will not be able to come into the evening performance. It is very upsetting for parents to miss their child's performance because they have not made appropriate arrangements. And it is also very difficult for staff who have to turn them away.

The afternoon performance will not be ticketed. Children below school age should be brought to the afternoon performance and not the evening performance.

Some children have been asked to bring in items from home to wear, if this is your child a note explaining this can be found in their reading records.

Vocabulary: part, part, whole, number bond, addition, subtraction, tens frame, multiple of 10, 10 more/ 10 less, 1 more, 1 less.

The children used their skills from the last 10 weeks to create their own attacking and defending games in small groups. All of the children have really enjoyed this programme and have improved their dribbling and ball skills because of it.
