Our Journey through Lent

They will take part in many book related activities throughout the day whilst wearing their pyjamas. As mentioned in the January newsletter. We are still experiencing a lot of children discussing messages they receive through groups that they are too young to be a part of. The age restrictions for these groups are:

Snapchat 13+

DisCord 13+

Instagram 13+

There is a reason for these age restrictions as children are not mature enough yet to deal with the consequences of messaging/communicating. In school we experience the upset when children write inappropriate messages or post unkind things about other children or even staff. It is vital that if parents decide to issue their child with a phone they must be in full control of when and how the children are using it. Some children are arriving in school tired from online gaming or using phones late into the night – this leads to poor behaviour and concentration which affects their learning.
