

## Year 3 Update 02.02.24

### RE

This week we have been thinking about the importance of prayer. The children thought about the different prayers they say in school and when and why they say them. They also prepared for their Mass celebration with Fr Tim.

Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Sabbath (Shabbat)	In Judaism and Christianity, the Sabbath is the day of the week set aside for worship and rest. In Hebrew—the language of ancient Israel—the word is Shabbat, which comes from a term meaning “cease” or “rest.”
synagogue	A synagogue is a place of worship for people of the Jewish religion.
scriptures	the books of the Old and New Testaments, or of either of them

### English

This week in English the children completed their newspaper article about *The Three Little Pigs*. The children self and peer corrected their writing with green pen to ensure they had included all the key features.

Key vocabulary: conjunctions, direct/reported speech, alliteration, headline, adverb.

### Maths

This week the children looked at the relationship between multiplication and division and began to divide amounts using partitioning. We will continue with this work next week. Regular practise on TTRockstars will really help your child and a *little and often* approach is recommended. The program recognises the calculations your child struggles on based on the time it takes them to answer the question and then gives it to them more often to increase their fluency. Just 5 minutes every day would really help them!

Key vocabulary: share, equal, how many, inverse, groups of, partition.

### Messages
