<u>Year 5 update</u>

As part of our next topic *Memorial Sacrifice* the children have been studying the Last Supper and made links with Passover. They looked at a selection of different pictures of the Last Supper and discussed the symbols that were used and how each character was depicted.

We then moved on to think about how the Eucharist is a memorial of Christ's sacrifice on the Cross, and that every time the Eucharist is celebrated we are keeping the memory of Jesus alive. The children responded by creating their own guide to the Eucharist.

Key vocabulary: Eucharist, communion, community, unity

Maths

This week we have revisited children's use of the formal methods of multiplication and division. We spent a couple of lessons consolidating their understanding of the bus stop method and instances where the answer includes a remainder. As we are now halfway through the year we have carried out an arithmetic assessment which will be useful in pinpointing areas of focus in future lessons.

English

We continue to use Harry Potter as our inspiration in English lessons. The children have annotated extracts from the text identifying how tension and suspense have been built.

Next week the children will be writing their own section of the story using a variety of techniques to build suspense.

We have also assessed the children's progress in spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Key vocabulary: tension, suspense.

Science

We have started our new topic by naming and identifying the planets found in our solar system and finding out the distance between each planet and the sun.

Key vocabulary: solar system, Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune., sun.
