World Book Day - Thursday 7th March

This year on World Book Day we will be supporting a charity a called Children with Cancer UK. This charity has been chosen by staff in our Year 3 classes. They would like the whole school to take part by making a donation via The Gateway. On Thursday 7th March there will be a 'Cosy and Comfortable Day' where the children are invited to come to school wearing their pyjamas, a onesie or an oodie. They will take part in many book related activities throughout the day whilst wearing their pyjamas. The reason for the link to pyjamas is many children undergoing treatment will stay overnight in hospitals and their familiar pyjamas can be a great source of comfort. During recovery, families can go through multiple pairs of sleepwear in a short space of time as their child will spend most of their time in bed or on a sofa. The donations will be sent to Children with Cancer UK after World Book Day.

<u>RE</u>

This week in RE we have learnt about the four different parts of Mass: gathering, listening, giving thanks, and going out. The children have also reflected on the Eucharistic prayer and thought about the meaning of the words in this. They have drawn their own pictures of what they think Heaven and Earth look like in God's glory.

Next week, we will be continuing our work on the Eucharistic prayer.

Vocabulary: Mass, gather. Gospel. Eucharistic, thanksgiving.

English

This week we have continued our work on Samson's Titanic Journey by beginning our own newspaper report based on the Titanic. The children have looked at an example of a newspaper report and identified the features. They have then written their own headlines, opening sentences and introduction to their newspaper reports.

Next week, we will finishing our newspaper reports.

Vocabulary: features, headline, caption, opening sentence, Titanic, iceberg.

Maths

This week in maths the children have been looking at arithmetic and reasoning questions and using all of their maths knowledge to help support answering different types of questions. We have been recapping number bonds to 10 and 20, doubles, adding 2-digit numbers, taking away, word problems, multiplying and adding 3 1-digit numbers.

Next week: we will be moving onto fractions. The children will be recapping wholes and part and equal and unequal groups and they will be introduced to the $\frac{1}{2}$ fraction sign.

Vocabulary: fraction, equal, unequal, numerator, denominator, half, whole, part

DT

We are going to be starting our new DT Topic this week. To begin with we will be thinking about the Eat Well Plate and what is good for our bodies.

Vocabulary: Eat well, healthy, protein, carbohydrate, sugar, dairy, fruit and vegetables.
