Year 3 Update 1.3.24

RE

This week, we began our new topic called 'Listening and Sharing' where we learnt about the four parts of the Eucharist: We Gather/Introductory Rite, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of the Eucharist and the Dismissal/Concluding Rite. We looked in detail at what happens in each part of the ceremony and the importance of some of the actions and words that are said during this time. Next week, we will learn about the second part of the Eucharist in more detail and look at the importance of the words in the Gloria which is a prayer praising and glorifying God.

Key vocabulary: Sacrament, Eucharist, Mass, gathering, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of the Eucharist, Holy Communion, homily, ambo, altar, rite

English

This week we started our new text called 'Dr Xargle's Book of Earth Hounds'.' The children have made predictions based on the front cover, characters and setting. We have also started to learn about features of non-chronological reports. Next week, we will sort the information they gather from the text under the relevant subheadings and begin to write their own non chronological report as if they are aliens describing dogs in Earth.

Key vocabulary: Non chronological, diagram, heading, sub-heading, facts.

Maths

Over the next few weeks, we will be focusing on length using mm, cm and m. This week, the children focused on the appropriate units to use when measuring various objects. They also reviewed how to use a ruler in order to get an accurate length.

Key vocabulary: ruler, measure, length, centimetre, metre, millimetre
