

Year 3 Update 14.3.24

Thank you to all the parents who attended parents evening this week, it was lovely to see you all. The children also thoroughly enjoyed alien day, it was a lovely way to celebrate our current text in English.

RE

In RE this week, the children have started their new topic called 'Giving all.' We have started to learn about the special Liturgical season of Lent. The children know that we are currently celebrating Lent and that this is a special time when we prepare for Easter. The children identified that the Liturgical colour for the season of Lent is purple, and they reviewed the Lenten promises they made and discussed if they have been able to keep to them. They have also thought about the importance of prayer during Lent, thinking about the three main practices of Lent- fasting, almsgiving and prayer.

Key Vocabulary- Almsgiving, prayer, liturgical, thanksgiving, fasting, charity

English

In English, the children have continued with their new text called Dr Xargle's Earth Hounds. They have been learning about the features of non-chronological reports and have written a glossary for the text. During Alien Day, the children also designed their own aliens, writing about its appearance and characteristics. Next week, they will begin planning their own non-chronological reports.

Maths

This week we have continued measuring, the children thought about how to convert measurements from cm into mm and mm into cm. Next week, they will be looking at equivalent lengths and start comparing lengths.
