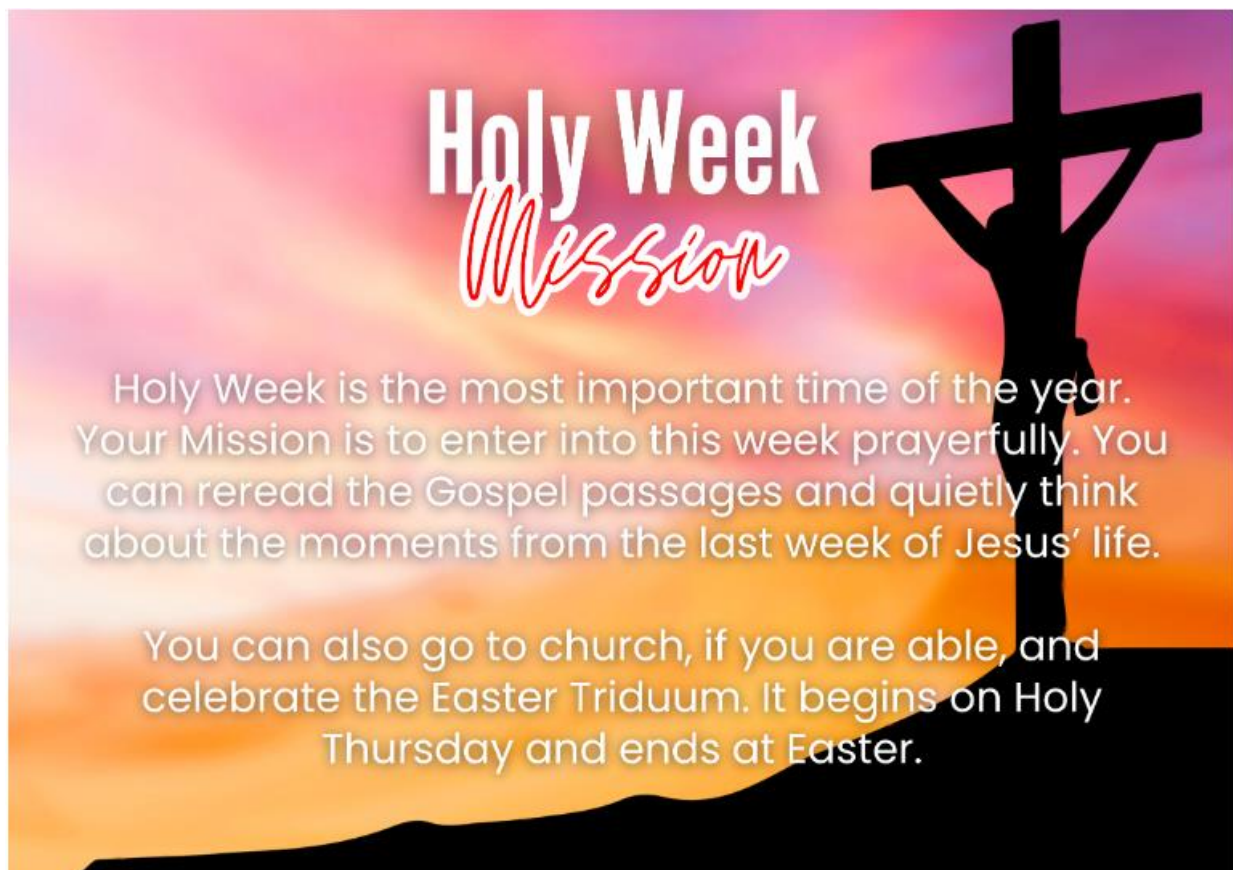
RE
