RE

In RE this week, we have been learning about the Introductory Rite and how Mass helps us to follow the advice given by Jesus. We looked at how the first part of the mass prepares us for the Eucharist and thought about what the Rite looks like when we go to church ourselves.

Key Vocabulary: Introductory Rite, sacristy, gather, prepare, hymns, Sing of the Cross.

English

This week in English we have started our new topic of Script Writing. We have explored the features of a script and looked at the similarities and differences of a script compared to a storybook. We were then able to identify the features of a script by colour coding each feature in the opening scene of Alice in Wonderland.

Key Vocabulary: script, characters, scene, similarities, differences, stage directions.

Pre-Teaching

Next week we will be improvising speech from a story to see how we can transform a book into a script.

Maths

This week in maths we have been looking at shapes. We identified the features of a quadrilateral and triangle as well as looking at different angles.

Key Vocabulary: quadrilateral, triangle, angle, vertices, length, equal.
