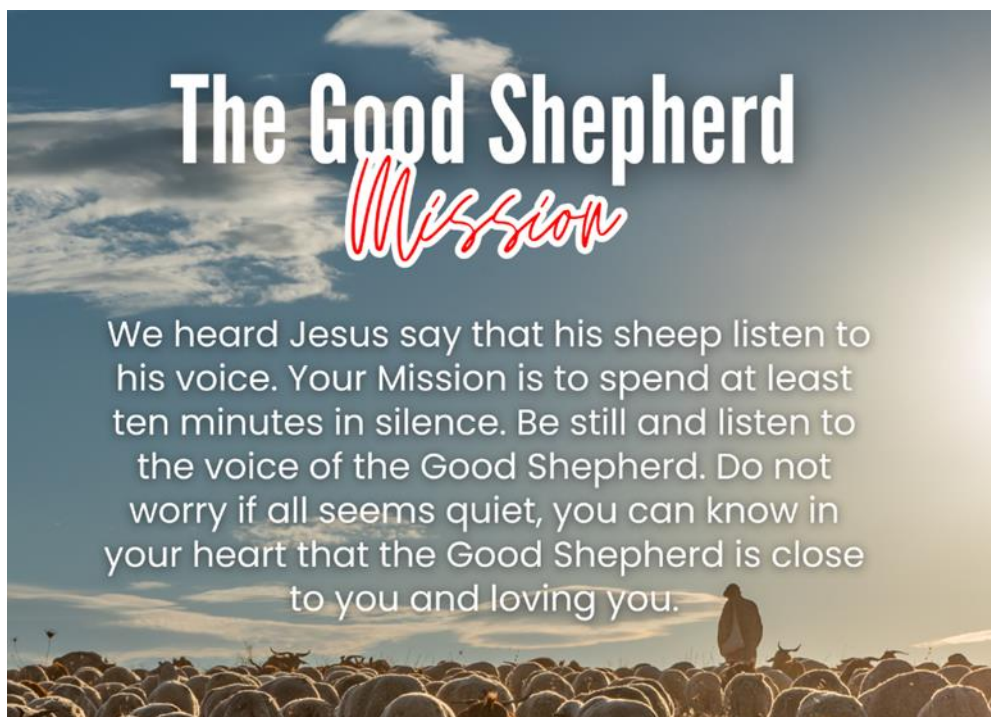
RE

English

In English this week we started looking at our new topic of Roman mythology. We explored the gods and goddesses and carried out some research to see if we could find out any interesting facts about them.
