

Year 6 Update – Friday 24TH May 2024

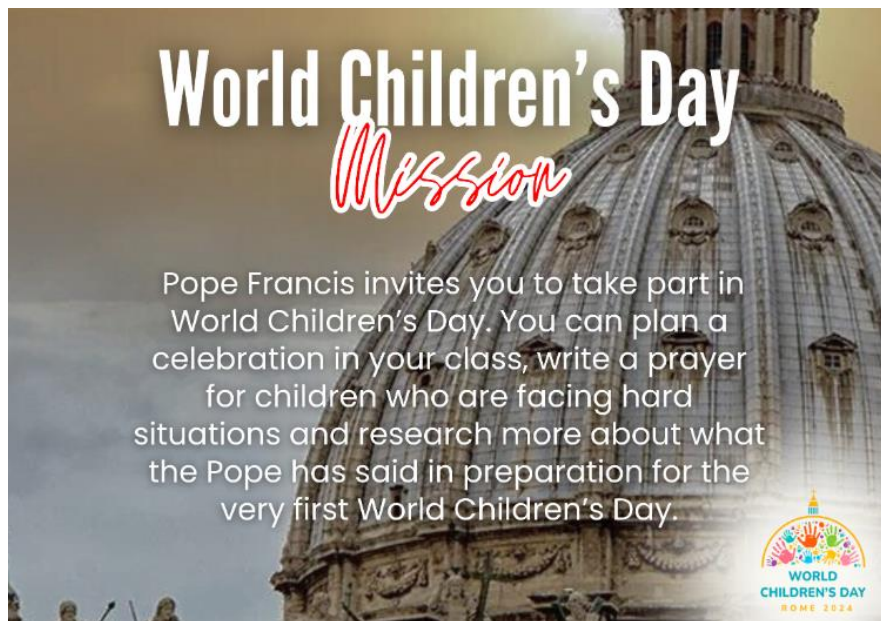
