RE

This week in RE we have been thinking about forgiveness. The children have thought about what forgiveness means, how they feel when they make wrong choices and how they feel when they ask for forgiveness and say sorry. They have also looked at Jesus' teachings of forgiveness.

Next week: we will be looking at how peace comes from forgiveness.

Vocabulary: Jesus, Holy Spirit, rules, actions, right, wrong. Forgiveness, faith, prayer, sorry

English

The children have continued our work on James and the Giant Peach this week. They have looked at three different settings and generated adjectives to describe these. They have then written a setting description of the peach focussing on using adjectives and similes.

Next week, the children will be completing an independent piece of writing based on the story.

Vocabulary: simile, adjective, setting, description

Maths

This week the children have started our topic on statistics in maths. They have looked at, used and created tally charts. We have looked at tables and block diagrams and have started to look at pictograms.

Next week: continuing to work on reading, interpreting and creating pictograms

Vocabulary: chart, table, tally, block diagram, pictogram, graph, axis

RHE

This week we have learnt about the life cycle of a human and how much God loves us at every stage of our life.

DT

As part of our DT topic, children have created their own moving monsters using levers, linkages, and split pins. They carefully designed their monster, then created it out of card. We were impressed with the creativity of the children.
