
<u>RE:</u> In RE this week began our topic on reconciliation. We have started the topic by talking about situations where we have to choose what to do and how sometimes we make good choices - good for others and for ourselves - and sometimes we make wrong choices which make others and ourselves unhappy.


<u>Key vocabulary:</u> choice, happy, sad, disappointed, sorry, forgive, rules, wrong, right, feeling, love, Sign of Peace, Peace be with you

<u>English</u>: In English this week we have been focusing on our phonics in preparation for the Phonics Screening. We have been encouraging the children to be more confident in choosing the correct sound when spelling words across all subjects and reminding them of the importance of forming letters correctly and consistently on the line.

Key vocabulary: capital letter, full stop, because, so, but, adjective

<u>Maths</u>: This week we have started work on fractions. We began by investigating halves of shapes and objects. Later in the week we continued by working out halves of quantities.





Key vocabulary: half, halves, equal, groups, counting, altogether, whole, share

<u>Science</u>: This week the children have started work on a new topic Seasonal Change. We began by discussing what we know about the seasons and the children went on to make a seasons mobiles in groups. (We explained to the children what mobiles were before we had mobile phones ©.)

<u>Key vocabulary</u>: Seasons, seasonal celebration, autumn, winter, spring, summer, daylight hours, weather forecast

Extra information:

The children behaved exceptionally well in Church on Wednesday and walked back to school very sensibly.
