<u>RE</u>

We have started our new topic of 'rules'. The children have discussed why it is important we have rules and why they are important. We have thought about how are we God's people so should follow his rules. The children thought about right and wrong and sorted actions into right and wrong.

Vocabulary: Jesus, Holy Spirit, rules, St Paul, actions, right, wrong.

<u>English</u>

This week the children have started reading the story 'James and the Giant Peach' by Roald Dahl. We have been looking at the characters in the story, writing descriptions and using adjectives. We have also been reading the story together in class.

Next week, we will continue to look at this story and look at the settings where the story takes place.

Vocabulary: character, adjective, describe, setting, where, who, what

Maths

This week the children have started our unit on time and have been telling the time to the hour, half past, quarter to and quarter past. They have also been using their new knowledge to solve word problems.

Next week: the children will be moving onto telling the time to the nearest 5 minute interval.

Vocabulary: time, hour, minute, second, o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past

<u>RHE</u>

Over this half term the children will be completing a series of RHE lessons (Relationship and Health Education for Catholic Schools). During these lessons the children will be covering a range of topics, including keeping their bodies clean and healthy, their likes and dislikes, feelings that they have and how to manage these feelings and thinking about the cycle of life.

<u>Science</u>

Our Science topic this term is all about Plants. This week the children looked at some different seeds and made predictions about what flowers they would grow into. We looked at which plants grow from seeds and which plants grow from bulbs. The children also identified the parts of a flowering plant.

On Friday 14th June Year 2 will be doing their Fathers Day Assembly where we will be celebrating dads, grandads, uncles, brothers and anyone else who cares for the children.
