
This week we started our new topic called Choices. In this week's lessons we focused on what choices and consequences are. They learnt about how they can make good choices which have good consequences or bad choices which have bad consequences. They put ideas of good and bad choices on a table and worked together to decide what is the right thing to do. Next week, the children will be reading the story of the Prodigal Son.

Key vocabulary: choice, consequence, repentance, confession, reconciliation, penance

Maths

This week the children started their new topic where we are learning about money. We focused on identifying certain coins and how to make different amounts in a variety of ways. The children also converted pounds into pence and vice versa. Next week we will be adding and subtracting money and working out how to find change.

Key Vocabulary: money, notes, coins, convert, change



English

This week, we have continued learning about instructions, the children have been learning about how to write in the first, second and third person and understand that instructions are written in the second person. They have also learnt how to use verbs and adverbs in a sentence. Next week, they will re-write a continuous piece of text in the format of instructions and begin planning their own instructions.

Key Vocabulary: instructions, verbs, adverbs, first person, second person, third person

Science

In Science, the children have been introduced to their new topic on light and shadows. This week they learnt about sources of light, identifying natural and man-made light sources.

Key Vocabulary: light, light source, dark, absence of light, transparent, translucent, opaque, shiny, matt, surface, shadow, reflect, mirror, sunlight
