### RE

This week the children learnt about God's forgiveness through the story of the Prodigal Son and created a storyboard board of the events that took place and considered what they would have done if they were the son's father. The children also learnt about the Sacrament of Reconciliation and analysed the Prayer of Sorrow and its importance to Catholics. Next week, we will re-enact the stages and actions of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Key vocabulary: conscience, sorrow, grace, penance, sin.

### English

In English the children have rewritten a set of instructions using the correct numbered steps, punctuation, and spelling. They have also begun to plan their instructions which they will be writing next week. We will then move on to looking at different Fables.

Key vocabulary: chronological order, imperative verbs, verbs, adverbs

### Maths

The children have now finished their maths topic on money where we have been leaning how to find change. We have now moved on to our topic on time where the children have looked at Roman Numerals and labelling a clock with 5-minute intervals.
