<u>RE</u>

This week in RE we have been thinking about peace. The children have thought about what peace means and about how reconciliation can bring about peace. We discussed the sign of peace used in Mass and they had a go at writing their own acrostic poems about peace.

<u>English</u>

We have completed our work on James and the Giant Peach this week. The children have completed an independent piece of writing retelling the story and creating their own ideas of where the peach lands. The children all worked hard to use the different grammatical features we have learnt about this year in their work - well done year 2!

Next week, we will be looking at Roald Dahl's Revolting Rhymes.

<u>Maths</u>

This week the children have looked at pictograms. They have been able to read pictograms where different scales have been used as a key. They have answered a range of questions about the data displayed in a pictograms as well as creating their own.

<u>Science</u>

As part of our plants topic the children are carrying out an experiment to answer the question 'Do plants need light to grow?' They have planted seeds and put them in different places around the classroom with different amounts of lights. Over the next couple of weeks we will be measuring how high each of our plants grow.
