RE

In RE this week, we have continued to explore the symbols and words of Reconciliation and thought about the different ways this Rite may be done in Church. We have also been learning about absolution.

Our learning this week:

English

In English this week we have reviewed our spelling rules, completed comprehension and recapped some grammar that we have learnt over the year, including using inverted commas and learning about determiners.

Key Vocabulary: determiner, inverted comma, direct speech, reporting clause.

Maths

This week in maths we have continued to review our learning of area and have looked at finding the area of some simple compound shapes.

Key Vocabulary: area, perimeter, squared, units.

Science

In science, we have continued looking at the States of Matter by exploring the different states of water. We have looked at the processes water goes through when it changes state.

We spoke to a Friar and had the opportunity to ask questions about what he does daily and got to learn some of the history of the Carmelite Friars.
