

Year 4 Update

RE

In RE this week, we have reflected on the things we have done wrong and thought about how God's law of love has been broken as well as looking at ways that these could be repaired. We then explored the symbols and words of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and wrote our own Act of Contrition.

Key Vocabulary: Building Bridges, reflection, law of love, Sacrament of Reconciliation, Act of Contrition.

RE Mission of the Week:

As we encounter Jesus, he invites us to live our lives differently. This week's mission is a suggestion of how we can do just that.

Saints Peter and Paul *Mission*

Jesus is the God of second chances. If you make a mistake or do something wrong, don't become frustrated. Instead turn to Jesus, say you are sorry and receive his forgiveness. You could also go to church and receive the beautiful Sacrament of Reconciliation.

English

In English this week we received a letter explaining that our help was needed to come up with the blueprints of a new invention. We then started our own explanation text by thinking about the importance of a good title and introduction before writing our own.

Key Vocabulary: explanation, imperative verb, time conjunction, title, subheading, image/diagram, invention, design, introduction.

Pre-Teaching

Next week we will be continuing to write our explanation text.

Maths

This week in maths we have reviewed our learning of fractions by finding the fraction of an amount and looking at improper fractions.

Key Vocabulary: fraction, numerator, denominator, part, whole number, improper fraction.

Pre-Teaching

Next week we will be recapping how to work out the area and perimeter of a shape.

Science

In science, we have continued looking at the States of Matter by exploring real life objects and thinking about where they would fit in a Venn diagram of the three states. We explored how some objects have properties of more than one state and they are therefore difficult to organise.

This week there will be maths and spelling homework. Maths will be given out as a paper copy and spellings will be stuck into spelling books as usual. Please complete homework in the correct books and hand them back on the following days:
