Year 3 Update 5.7.24

<u>RE</u>

This week the children finished their topic on Choices. They learnt about the Sacrament of Reconciliation and analysed the Prayer of Sorrow and its importance to Catholics. They re-enacted the stages and actions of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and then made an informative booklet explaining what happens during confession. They also studied St Paul's letter to the Thessalonians and thought about the choices they should make as followers of Jesus.

Key vocabulary: conscience, sorrow, grace, penance, sin.

<u>English</u>

This week the children began their learning on Haiku poems, they were able to identify the features of these types of poems and fill in the gaps for Haiku poems they were given ensuring they used the correct number of syllables. They also wrote their own Haiku poem about the four different seasons. Next week, we will start our new topic on Fables.

Key vocabulary: Haiku, poetry, syllables

Maths

The children continued with their work on time and have been learning how to tell the time using past and to and also looked at telling the time to 5 minutes and a minute. Once again, it would be very beneficial for your child to get as much practise as possible of telling the time using an analogue clock at home.

Key vocabulary: roman numerals, clock, hands, quarter past, quarter to, o'clock, half past

<u>Science</u>

This week the children completed an investigation to find out what surfaces reflect light. They learnt that light travels in a straight line. When light hits an object, it is reflected (bounces off). If the reflected light hits our eyes, we can see the object.

Key vocabulary: reflective material, prediction, conclusion.
