Maths

Topic: place value

• Children have compared numbers using the greater than and less than symbols. (<,>) Example question:

346,3_6 > 346,346

• Children have been learning about powers of 10. They have counted in 10s, 100s, 1000s, 10,000s and 100,000s.

Vocabulary: digit, representation, value, place value column, tens, ones, hundred, thousands, ten thousands, millions, rounding, power of 10.

Next week: the children will be rounding numbers.

<u>Science</u>

Topic: Materials - properties and changes

• Children carried out a scratch experiment to test the hardness of different objectives.

Vocabulary: hardness, property, softness, pattern seeking

Next week: children will be determining the transparency of different materials.
