RE

- In R.E this week we have begun to look at the Sacrament of Baptism.
- We have recreated a Baptism and looked at each of the different symbols of Baptism.
- Next week, we will look at the significance of the oil used in Baptism.

Vocabulary: signs, symbols, Sacrament, significant, Baptism,

English

- This week we have written a set of instructions on how to be a good friend.
- We looked at the vocabulary we could use to help make our instructions even better, e.g. reliable, kind, honest, brave, sensitive etc.
- Next week, we will be moving onto a new unit of work about poetry.

Vocabulary: instructions, command sentence, imperative verb, friend, vocabulary

Maths

- This week we have started our topic of addition.
- We have focused on adding and taking away 9 and 11 using rebalancing, for example $8+9=7+10=17$ or $18-11 = 17-10 = 7$.
- Next week, we will be consolidating number bonds to 10 and 100.

Vocabulary: addition, subtraction, rebalancing, number, value.

Science

- We have continued our research using the internet on woodland habitats and the animals which live in them.
- Next week, we will be looking at food chains.

Vocabulary: habitat, research, woodland, predator, consumer.
