We dedicated our song to the children around the world in developing countries whose future has already been written due to their lack of food and water.

Religious Education

- This week in R.E the children have been looking closely at the themes of unconditional love, forgiveness and reconciliation in the Parable of the Prodigal Son.
- The children wrote about how these link to the scripture passage but also to their own lives too.

Vocabulary: unconditional love, forgiveness, reconciliation

Pre learning:

• Next week we will be looking at Jesus' Sermon on the Mount and how the Beatitudes prayer which originates from this teaching relates to our own lives.

Mathematics

- Padua looked at adding and subtracting negative numbers.
- Lisbon looked at the formal methods for addition and subtraction including decimals and money.

Vocabulary: negative, positive, decimal point, columns, exchanging

English

- This week the children have continued with their mystery and suspense writing.
- They have carried on with their work from last week where they are describing the night watchman's journey to work while building up tension and moving the story on.

Vocabulary: varied sentence length, repetition, show not tell

Pre-learning:

• Next week they will finish off editing this writing.

 We will then move onto incorporating a dialogue between the night watchman and museum manager while considering the levels of formality between these two characters.

Science

- Padua have started looking at different types of warm-blooded animals and will be creating a fact-file.
- Lisbon have been continuing writing up their fact-file about cold-blooded animals.

Vocabulary: amphibian, reptile, fish, mammals, birds, warm-blooded, cold-blooded, body temperature, regulate

Pre- learning:

- Next week the children will be finishing off their fact-files.
- The children will then start to learn about invertebrates.
