#### **Nursery and Reception Nativity Performance**

For the Year 1 and Year 2 performance there will be an afternoon performance (2.30pm) and an evening performance (6pm).

Numbers for the evening performance will need to be restricted so we will be sending home two tickets for each family in Years 1 and 2. Please organise babysitters in advance as all children who attend our school as well as pre-school children will not be able to come into the evening performance. It is very upsetting for parents to miss their child's performance because they have not made appropriate arrangements. And it is also very difficult for staff who have to turn them away.

The afternoon performance will not be ticketed. Children below school age should be brought to the afternoon performance and not the evening performance.
