RE

- In R.E this week we have focused on Remembrance Day.
- The children created beautiful poppies to remember those who lost their lives fighting for us.
- Next week, we will begin our other faith topic of Judaism.

Vocabulary: remembrance, poppy, war, conflict, peace.

English

- This week we have started to look at a new focus text called 'Last stop on Market Street' by Matt de la Pena.
- The children have identified and use verbs in the past tense to write sentences about the story.
- We have also looked at the spelling rule 'adding ed' when using verbs in the past tense.

Vocabulary: verb, noun, adjective, consider, wonder, past tense.

Maths

- This week we have continued to use the Think 10 method to add two 2 digit numbers.
- We have also used the same method to subtract a two digit number by a one digit number.
- Next week, we will be focusing on the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.
