Year 6 Update – Friday 31st January 2025

Vocabulary: comma, semi colon, subordinate clause, main clause, subordinating conjunction, coordinating conjunction


Pre-learning

 Next week the children will be starting a new topic based on the book, 'Arthur Spiderwick's Field Guide to the Fantastical World Around You.'

Mathematics

 This week Year 6 Lisbon have been looking at translating shapes around a grid and how a translated shape doesn't change size or orientation when it is translated e.g.

A child might be given a shape on squared paper like this (the rectangle in blue) and then asked to translate it 5 down and 6 to the right, resulting in the rectangle in red:



• This week Year 6 Padua have been looking at units of measure e.g. grams, kilograms, metres, kilometres etc. and converting between them.

Vocabulary: vectors, coordinates, orientation, metric, unit

Pre-learning

Next week we will be looking at the area and perimeter of different shapes.

Science

- Year 6 Lisbon carried out an experiment this week to investigate how the size of a shadow can be affected by the distance a light source is away from an object.
- We also discussed the angle of reflection and how this differs depending on how shiny a surface is.

Vocabulary: shadow, reflection, incidence, ray
