Measles Information - very important information

We have recently been informed of an increase of cases of measles in the local area. The advice we have been given from UK Health Agency is to ensure that parents are well informed about the symptoms of measles, how it spreads and about vaccination against measles. There is an important fact sheet attached to this newsletter which I would urge all parents to read. Parents of children who do develop rashes will be asked to speak to their GP as soon as possible for advice in case it is the measles rash. Having the MMR vaccine is the best way to prevent measles. If your child has not had the MMR vaccine the advice is to talk to your GP as this vaccine gives long-term protection against measles, mumps and rubella.

World Book Day – Thursday 6th March

This year on **World Book Day** we will be asking the children to come to school dressed as their favourite book character. There will be activities throughout the day to encourage a love of reading.

As previously explained in the email that was sent to parents on Friday 14th February - There is also an optional challenge for all the children. Can they create a story show box using an old shoe box or cereal

box? If your child would like to take part in this optional activity, please can they bring the box into school on the **6**th **March.** After school these will be on show in the Activity Studio for parents to see. Come and have a look if you have a chance.

Attendance Update

The whole school attendance has been **95%** from **1st September 2024** until **26th February 2025**. If your child is absent from school, please telephone/email each day to keep the school office informed. Please remember we are unable to authorise any absence for holidays/trips/visits/celebrations. Recently County have issued fines to families where children have had 10 sessions of unauthorised absence. One day of school is equal to 2 sessions. Absences directly before or after a school holiday cannot be authorised without evidence for the absence. This may include medical evidence if your child is unwell or evidence of delayed flights or circumstances beyond your control.

Children who have below 90% attendance will receive a letter from school as under the guidelines, we also have to refer children's attendance figures to the local authority attendance team if they have had more than 15 days illness.
