<p>Creation and Covenant</p> <p>In this unit we read from the book of Genesis and learn about how Christian's believe God created the world. We learn that God created us, and that everybody is special. We also learn how to care for God's creations. We learn about how we are part of several communities, including the Church where we were welcomed through Baptism.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: God, World, creation, Bible, Genesis, beautiful, love, Baptism</p>	<p>Prophecy and Promise</p> <p>In this unit we read from the book of Luke and celebrate Advent and Christmas.</p> <p>We also learnt about Diwali and Remembrance.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: God, Mary, Jesus, Bethlehem, shepherds, Joseph, Nativity, wreath, Crib, angel, manger, Advent</p>	<p>Galilee to Jerusalem</p> <p>We start this term celebrating and learning about Epiphany.</p> <p>We then go on to reading different parables from the Bible to better learn about what Jesus was like as an adult and what He taught us.</p> <p>We also celebrate Candlemas.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: wise men, Magi, gifts, blessing, Glory Be, welcome, love, prayer</p>	<p>Desert to Garden</p> <p>In this unit we celebrate the season of Lent. We mark Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wednesday and learn about Holy Week.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: Lent, Jesus, cross, New Life, rose, resurrection, Good Friday, Holy Week, Easter Sunday, ashes, palms</p>	<p>To the Ends of the Earth</p> <p>We celebrate the resurrection of Jesus and the coming of spring.</p> <p>The children learn about Ascension and Pentecost.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: Easter, resurrection, New Life, Holy Spirit, Pentecost, Apostle, church, family, parish and community.</p>	<p>Feast Days, the World and other religions</p> <p>The children celebrate the feast days of St Peter and St Paul and of our patron saint St Anthony.</p> <p>We visit Holy Rood church and learn about a synagogue and a mosque.</p> <p>We celebrate our cultural heritage by holding a multicultural day.</p> <p>Key vocabulary: saints, feast day, synagogue, mosque, church, family, parish and community.</p>
