### RE

Vocabulary: subtrahend, minuend, addend, sum, total, difference.

# Geography

- The children have created a beautiful piece of work explaining why polar bears do not live in Antarctica.
- We will be concluding our topic next week by looking at Antarctic animals.

Vocabulary: climate, extreme, adaptation, habitat, species, diet.
