Year 6 SATs

Year 6 children will be taking part in the Year 6 National SATs week - **Monday 12th May – Thursday 15th May.** They have been working very hard in class and during booster sessions to prepare for this important week. Complimentary breakfast will be offered to children in Year 6 who would like to come into school at the earlier time of 8.10am that week. Staff provide a range of tasty goodies to keep up their energy levels. This will take place in our Activity Studio. More information will be sent to Year 6 parents.

Water Bottles

The weather is finally becoming warmer so please ensure you send your child to school with an appropriate water bottle. The water bottle you send in with your child must have a sports cap not a screw on lid. These need to be plastic reusable bottles, no glass please. There are some expensive water bottles that have been brought into school - I would advise you avoid these as children get very upset if they are misplaced or are dropped. A cheap, replaceable water bottle is best.

Attendance Update

The whole school attendance has been 95% from 1st September 2024 until 19th March 2025. If your child is absent from school, please telephone/email each day to keep the school office informed. Please remember we are unable to authorise any absence for holidays/trips/visits/celebrations. Recently County have issued fines to families where children have had 10 sessions of unauthorised absence. One day of school is equal to 2 sessions. Absences directly before or after a school holiday cannot be authorised without evidence for the absence. This may include medical evidence if your child is unwell or evidence of delayed flights or circumstances beyond your control.

Children who have below 90% attendance will receive a letter from school as under the guidelines, we also have to refer children's attendance figures to the local authority attendance team if they have had more than 15 days illness.
