RE

- This week we have introduced the fruits of the Holy Spirit.
- The children have discussed what these are and made posters about how we can live these out in our daily lives.
- Next week, we will be continuing this by looking at the life of St Therese of Lisieux.

Vocabulary: Holy Spirit, faithfulness, kindness, saints, determination.

English

- This week we have moved onto our new non-fiction unit 'How to wash a Woolly Mammoth'. The children have been identifying imperative verbs.
- The children have sequenced instructions for hand washing and teeth washing.
- *Vocabulary: imperative verb, command, instructions, equipment*

Maths

- This week we have continued our topic on fractions.
- We have been finding halves, quarters and thirds of amounts.
- Next week, we will be looking at finding three quarters.

Vocabulary: fractions, quarter, third, half, denominator, numerator.

Science

- This week we have continued to water our plants and track their growth.
- We have learnt about how light affects the growth of a plant.
- Next week, we will be looking at the life cycle of a plant.

Vocabulary: seed, measure, comparative test, conditions, germination, seeds.
